

Coffee Hour with the Borough Manager by Steve Morus, Manager

Join me for coffee and doughnuts at 10 a.m. on Wednesday, October 24, in the Community Room of our new building.

My intent is to provide an opportunity to discuss the borough and how it operates. It will be non-partisan and non-political (the manager is an employee and not an elected official). I would first discuss a topic I feel is important—in this case, information on finances and the budget—and then provide you with an opportunity to raise issues or ask questions on borough operations.

Other than what will be discussed at the Coffee Hour, if you have other issues that need addressed you should contact the office separately so that someone on our staff can address the issue now. But if you would like an opportunity to understand borough operations better—be it the budget, our website, duties of various departments, or some other function—we can discuss it in an informal session for an hour or so over coffee.

I'm willing to meet with 2 or 20 people but to make sure we have sufficient food and a group size conducive to discussion, please register by calling the borough office at 412-351-7330 and leave your name, address and an email address or phone number, and specify that you would like to register for the coffee hour.

If you are interested in attending a meeting, but this time and date are not convenient, please call the borough office. Your input may be taken into consideration if future sessions are scheduled. If there is sufficient interest I'll try to schedule this session again. And if the idea works overall, we will make sure to schedule additional sessions via the Tree City Times and/or the borough's web-site (foresthillspa.org).

So, come for coffee on Wednesday, October 24. Pre-registration is required; space is limited so only those who are registered will be guaranteed admittance.
